Financial Report—Larry

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Period ending 8/31/2024—Cash on hand of \$119k against accounts payable and prepaid member fees of \$87k. Should carry us into summer wrap up and fall clean up with no problems. Member Fees of \$76k are tracking to budget with only one co-owner in the standard collection process.

Operating Expenses: Summer grounds expenses continue at expected levels and should be adequate thru year end. Sprinkler Repair of \$2k was less than expected, primarily due to the dry weather and Darwin's time being at a premium over all of the 633 Group

Properties. Other Contractors, \$14k covered the drain cleaning project and gutter issues that arose during the wet weather and numerous minor maintenance requests that were addressed.

Building and Other Maintenance represents standard summer maintenance projects. Structural Repair, \$9k was the result of a major water issue that came to light during the wet weather. Drywall Repair of \$2300 resulted from a leaking chimney flashing. All other expenses were either minor in nature or within expected ranges.

Reserve Account: In addition to the standard reserve transfer of \$31,600, \$2k in dividends and \$4k in initial fees on resale of homes was credited to the account. August window replacements of \$6412 were charged against the Reserve Account along with a new expense category of Front Door Replacement charged with \$7767, Siding of \$693 and Service Fee of \$10 finished off the Reserve payments.

Roofing Update —Aimee

Just a reminder of our Roofing Replacement Project that is coming to our Community

Important things to keep in mind:

- Work starting on October 7, 2024
- You will receive a note on your front door when they will be starting the next day on your home
- Make sure to remove all outdoor items, put them away. Bird Feeders, Flags, Planters, etc. ALSO your patio furniture, remove as much as you can and pull the balance of the furniture up close to your sliding glass door
- Keep ALL of your windows closed when they are working on your roof
- Crews working from 8 am until dusk, Monday through Friday
- No work will happen on poor weather days
- No roof will be torn off if it cannot be covered in the same day
- All shingles will be torn off before new shingles are installed
- They will have dumpsters placed within our community that they will be using, these dumpsters are **not** for resident use
- We will have roofing workers parking on the side of roads and in guest parking areas
- No new gutters should be installed during this time October 7—until end of roofing project
- Sheila will send out notices to give you updates, as much as possible
- There will be noise
- There will be inconvenience
- There will be times when you will be asked to not use your driveway, because the roofing crews will be working on your roof
- Please remember that the inconvenience that we will all experience, is coming at NO cost to any homeowner = No Assessment
- We are very lucky in our community to have this major expense taken care of by our insurance company
